

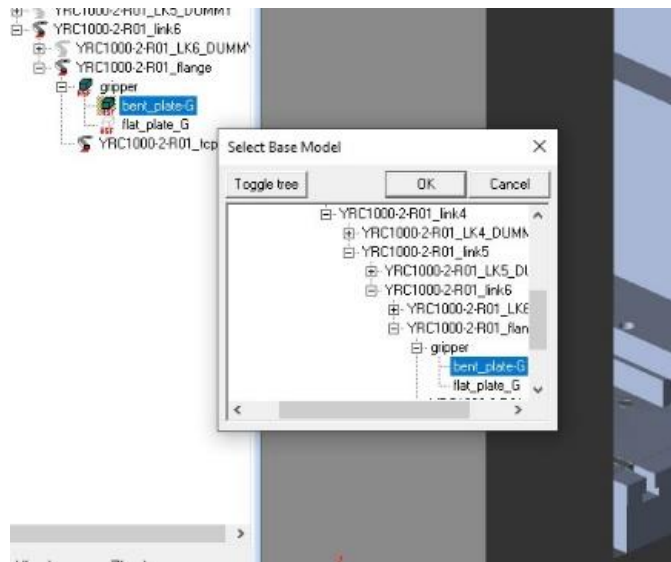
Exporting CAD Models from MotoSim

Sometimes, you need a model exported out of MotoSim to use in other programs for layout, etc. This will help you do that.

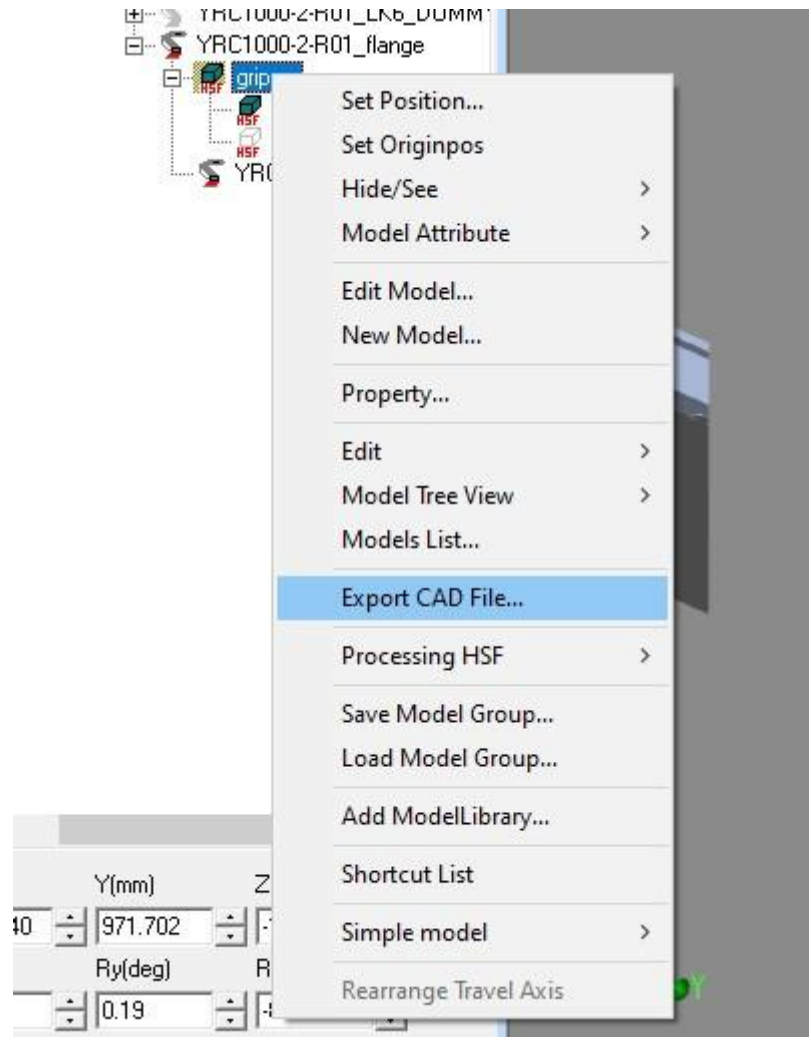
Picking and Exporting the model

1. Pick the model you want to export from the CAD tree.



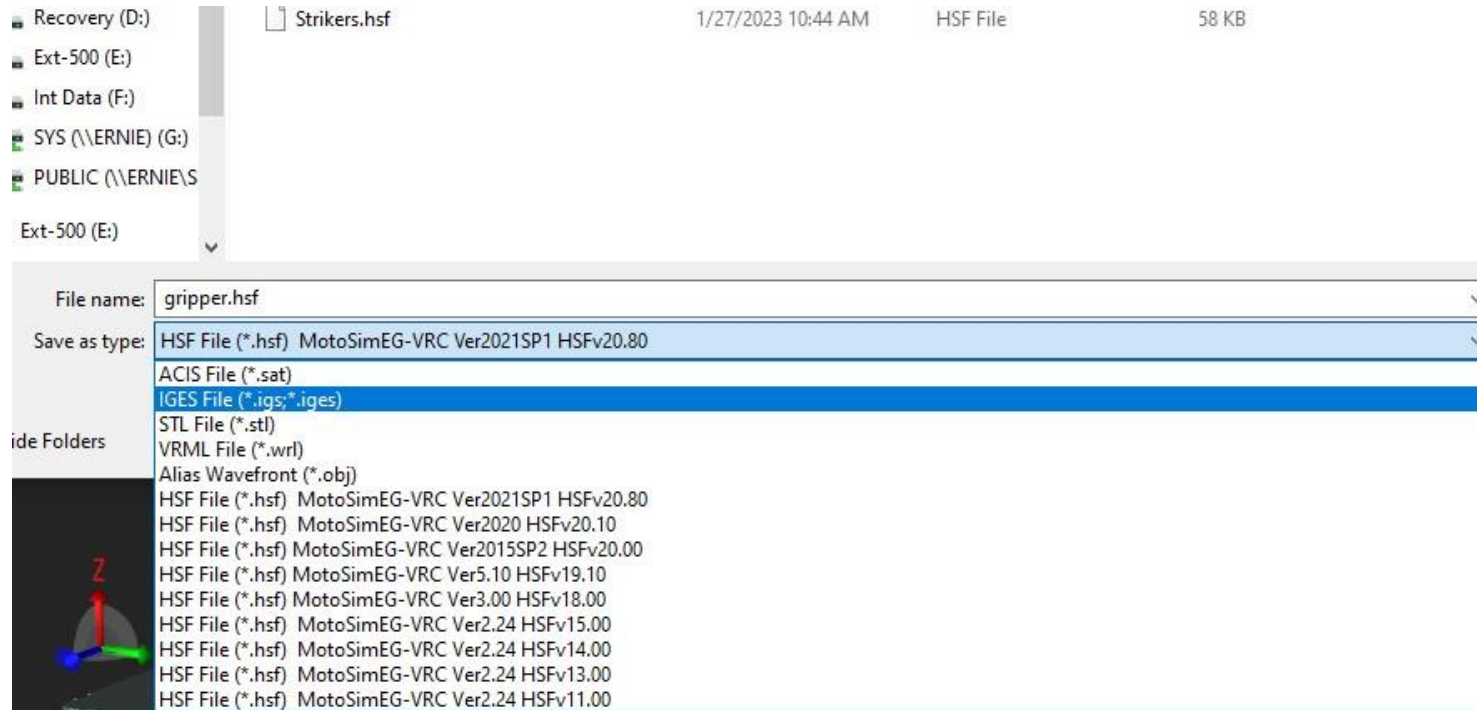
